ORDINANCE #2173-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY AMENDING CHAPTER 156 SEWERS, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 4 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY REGARDING INTEREST ON DELINQUENT SEWER RENTALS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury wishes to amend Chapter 156 Sewers, Article 1, Section 4 regarding the charging of interest on delinquent sewer rentals to conform with the Ordinance provisions for interest billings on delinquent water service billings.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that Chapter 156 Sewers, Article 1, Section 4 of the Code of the City of Woodbury is hereby amended and including the heading and shall henceforth read in its entirety as follows:

"§156-4. Billings for failure to pay.

Billings for sewer rentals, fees or installations thereof will be rendered quarterly on or before the 15th day of January, April, July and October. Bills remaining unpaid for the period of 30 days after they are rendered shall be charged interest at the rate of 8% per annum until such payment is made, and when such bill, or the accumulation of bills, is in excess of \$1,500, then interest shall be charged at the rate of 18% per annum until such bill or bills are paid. In computing the total outstanding bills, such computation shall include any outstanding and unpaid water bill or bills which shall be added to the unpaid sewer bills to determine the limit of \$1,500."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on January 22, 2013. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on February 12, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
