ORDINANCE NO. 2237-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY TO MANDATE DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES PURSUANT TO C. 52:14-15F ET SEQ.

- **WHEREAS,** P.L. 2013 c.28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and
- **WHEREAS**, P.L. 2013 c.28 permits governing bodies to grant exemptions on such terms and conditions as they deem necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY:

- **Section 1.** All employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the City of Woodbury are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation, as of November 1, 2015, in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under C.52:14-15f (b).
- **Section 2.** Seasonal and temporary employees who are employed by the City of Woodbury may be exempted from the direct deposit mandate.
- **Section 3.** If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- **Section 4.** All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with, or in conflict with, the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
- **THE FOREGOING** was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on September 1, 2015. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on September 22, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
