

ORDINANCE NO. 2273-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION
IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is an equal employment opportunity employer and is committed to an active affirmative action and diversity program; and

WHREAS, the City of Woodbury wishes to insure that its public works construction contractors and professional contractors are equal employment opportunity employers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that there is hereby created under Title 11, Article II to be entitled “Public Works Contracts and Professional Service Contracts, Non-Discrimination Provisions”, which shall read as follows:

A. Public Works contracts and professional service contracts shall contain a provision requiring that the contractor or sub-contractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.


B. All Public Works construction contracts shall contain a provisions that the contractor or sub-contractor, where applicable, will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other provisions of said Ordinance not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect and any ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on October 10, 2017. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on October 24, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
