

**RESOLUTION #14-143**

**A Resolution of the City of Woodbury Adopting Wellness  
Policy for the City of Woodbury and Appointing a  
Wellness Coordinator**

**WHEREAS**, the Joint Insurance Fund has appointed a Wellness Director charged with assisting municipalities in the creation and implementation of individualized municipal wellness activities in connection with the Joint Insurance Fund Safety Incentive Program; and

**WHEREAS**, research indicates that a healthier workforce can result in a shorter recovery time for injured workers, a faster return to work, a less absenteeism, increased productivity, and reduction in worker's compensation claims; and

**WHEREAS**, the Joint Insurance Fund has requested that its member municipalities adopt the attached Wellness Policy and appoint a local Wellness Coordinator to work with the Joint Insurance Fund's Wellness Director in implementing individualized municipal wellness activities.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Woodbury, that

The attached Wellness Policy Program Statement is hereby adopted and that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute same and forward to Sheila Ortiz, Account Representative, Arthur J. Gallagher Risk Management Solutions, P.O. Box 489, Marlton, NJ 08053 together with a copy of the within Resolution; and


2. Joy Dreyer is hereby appointed as the City of Woodbury's Wellness Coordinator.




### WELLNESS POLICY PROGRAM STATEMENT
