**RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FROM THE CITY OF
WOODBURY AUTHORIZING THE WOODBURY ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT OFFICE TO APPLY FOR A \$10,000 ENERGY PROJECT
SMALL GRANTS PROJECT THROUGH SUSTAINABLE JERSEY**

WHEREAS, a sustainable community seeks to optimize quality of life for its residents by ensuring that its environmental, economic and social objectives are balanced and mutually supportive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air and water, improve working and living environments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is participating in the Sustainable Jersey Program; and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the Sustainable Jersey Program is to provide resources to municipalities to make progress on sustainability issues, and they have created a grant program called the Sustainable Jersey Small Grants Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury has determined that the City of Woodbury should apply for the aforementioned Grant to secure funding to conduct a feasibility study to evaluate the energy effectiveness and efficiency of the current tree canopy in Woodbury's downtown business district from Salem Ave to Cooper Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Woodbury's Governing Body of the City of Woodbury, State of New Jersey, authorize the submission of the aforementioned Sustainable Jersey Grant for the amount of \$10,000.
