

RESOLUTION #14-189

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PLACEMENT OF MEMORIAL
MONUMENT FOR FIREFIGHTERS AT HENDRICKSON PARK**

WHEREAS, Daniel H. Davis, a member of the former Goodwill Fire Company No. 2 made the ultimate sacrifice giving his life responding to a fire call at 28 Newton Street, Woodbury, NJ on September 28, 1918; and

WHEREAS, September 28, 2018 will mark the 100th Anniversary of the death of Daniel H. Davis, the only Woodbury firefighter killed in the line of duty in the history of the Woodbury Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Friendship Fire Company No. 1 has requested authorization from the City of Woodbury to erect a monument dedicated to Daniel H. Davis and to all of the City of Woodbury Firefighters who have protected the City for more than 200 years; and


WHEREAS, Friendship Fire Company No. 1 has requested authorization to erect such monument within Hendrickson Park on the north side adjoining Cooper Street; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury wish to recognize the sacrifice of Daniel H. Davis and those who have protected the City of Woodbury by serving in its fire companies.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by City Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, that Friendship Fire Company No. 1 is hereby authorized to erect a monument within Hendrickson Park on the north side adjoining Cooper Street, the exact location and parameters of which are to be determined by the City Administrator in consultation with the Parks and Recreation Commission and Friendship Fire Company No. 1.
