

RESOLUTION #14-23
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAX ASSESSOR TO ACT AS AGENT FOR
THE CITY OF WOODBURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILING AND SETTLING
TAX APPEALS ON BEHALF OF THE TAXING DISTRICT FOR THE TAX
YEAR 2014

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor is knowledgeable regarding the valuation and assessment of properties in the City of Woodbury; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has the statutory responsibility, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-23 to 36 to set assessments for properties in the City of Woodbury under the Local Property Tax, N.J.S.A. 54:4-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Taxing District deems the Tax Assessor to be responsible and acting in the best interests of the Municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, that the Tax Assessor is hereby authorized to act as agent for the Taxing District without further governing body approval to:

(a) Determine when tax appeals, cross appeals, complaints and counterclaims should be filed on behalf of the Taxing District with regard to any property located in the City of Woodbury and accordingly direct the attorney for the Taxing District to file such documents with either the County Tax Board or Tax Court of the New Jersey as deemed appropriate; and


(b) Resolve and settle tax appeals pending before the County Tax Board, Tax Court or Appellate Courts for any tax year if the settlement results in a tax refund or tax credit not exceeding \$30,000.00 and authorize the attorney for the Tax District to formalize such settlement in the appropriate Court or County Tax Board.
