

RESOLUTION #15-142

**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE AUTHORIZATION FOR
EMERGENCY REPAIRS OF CITY RIGHTS OF WAY CAUSED BY
DOWNED CITY OWNED TREES AS A RESULT OF JUNE 23, 2015 STORM**

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2015 the City of Woodbury was impacted by a severe storm;
and

WHEREAS, as a result of the storm, numerous City owned trees within the City rights-of-way were downed causing significant damage to curbs and sidewalks and other damage within the City rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, while the City Code places responsibility for maintenance and repair of sidewalks, curbs, and other areas within the City rights-of-way on the adjoining property owner, due to the storm related cause of the damage, extent of the damage and as a matter of fundamental fairness, the City of Woodbury Council at its July 14, 2015 meeting by motion authorized the City Administrator to move forward with repair of damaged curbs and sidewalks within the City rights-of-way, and damage to the City rights-of-way caused by downed City owned trees within the City rights-of-way and removal of the downed trees; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury wish to memorialize such emergency authorization through formal resolution herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to take such actions as necessary including the hiring of outside contractors on an emergency basis to make repairs within the City rights-of-way, including curbs, sidewalks and the City rights-of-way and to remove City owned trees downed from the June 23, 2015 storm with respect to the 15 properties identified on attached Exhibit A and take any and all actions necessary or appropriate to secure FEMA or other disaster or emergency funding for same.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury held on July 28, 2015.
