RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE WOODBURY SCHOOL BOARD TO DISCONNECT A WATER MAIN CONNECTING EVERGREEN AVENUE AND N. BAYARD AVENUE AS PART OF THEIR PARKING LOT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Evergreen Avenue School is current undergoing a significant upgrade to their parking lot, student drop off and overall site plan; and

WHEREAS, during construction a 6" City water main was uncovered that runs from Evergreen Avenue through the school grounds, under the school at one point, and connects to North Bayard Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Woodbury School Board has requested that they be permitted to disconnect the line which will result in substantial savings in their construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the line was installed prior to the development of Rugby Place; and

WHEREAS, when Rugby Place was developed, it included installation of a water main connecting through to Hunter Street; and

WHEREAS, due to the Rugby Place main connection, the line the school uncovered has been determined to be not necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that the Woodbury School Board be permitted to disconnect the old line running from Evergreen Avenue through the school grounds to North Bayard Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury that:

- 1. The Woodbury School Board is hereby authorized to disconnect the 6" City water main running from Evergreen Avenue, through the school grounds, and connecting to N. Bayard Avenue; and
- 2. The City reserves the right to require to the Woodbury School Board and/or to itself reconnect said line in the event the City determines it necessary or desirable.
