**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (TRO)
REGARDING AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE ACCESS ZONE ON
ROUTE NJ 45 (BROAD STREET)**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury has requested that an investigation be conducted to determine the need for Do Not Block Intersection markings and signs along a portion of Route NJ 45 at the Woodbury Police Department entrance/exit for emergency vehicle access; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) has completed an investigation and has recommended that an *Emergency Vehicle Access Zone* be established; and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT requires a Resolution of support in order to promulgate the required Traffic Regulation Order establishing the *Emergency Vehicle Access Zone* pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 39:4-8.4c* from the City of Woodbury; and

WHEREAS, the Woodbury City Council has reviewed the request and recommends the establishment of the *Emergency Vehicle Access Zone* along Route NJ 45. ; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury has reviewed the proposed regulations and has determined that adoption of such regulations will support the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury, that it supports the NJDOT's TRO establishing the *Emergency Vehicle Access Zone* along Route NJ 45 as follows:

EMERGENCY VEHICLE ACCESS ZONE(S)

No person shall stop, stand, or obstruct a designated *Emergency Vehicle Access Zone* which has been clearly marked by "Do Not Block Intersection" markings and signs pursuant to Section 3B 17 of the current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Controls (M.U.T.C.D.), nor shall the driver move such vehicle into the clearly marked zone if proceeding traffic prevents immediate clearance of the *Emergency Vehicle Access Zone*.

Route NJ 45 (Broad Street)	East	All	Woodbury City Police Department's <i>Entrance/Exit</i> driveway beginning at a point 540 feet <i>north of the</i> <i>northerly</i> curb line of Courtland Street and extending 48 feet northerly therefrom (approximately milepost 25.65).

Repealer Clause:

The City of Woodbury concurs that any approved traffic regulation in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution be rescinded upon approval of the *Traffic Regulation Order*.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of the within Resolution containing the raised seal of the City of Woodbury to the State of New Jersey, Department of Transportation, Bureau of Traffic Engineering, P.O. Box 600, Trenton, NJ 08625-0600.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that is Resolution shall take effect upon approval of the Commissioner of Transportation as provided by law.
