RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY ADOPTING THE MITIGATION PLAN FOR FOUR NEW JERSEY COUNTIES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodbury recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of Woodbury; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury has participated in the preparation of the Mitigation Plan for Four New Jersey Counties, a multi-jurisdictional, multi-hazard mitigation plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Mitigation Plan for Four New Jersey Counties includes an Appendix that identifies mitigation goals, strategies, and measures specifically for the City of Woodbury to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property from the impacts of future hazard events and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City Council of the City of Woodbury demonstrates commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Mitigation Plan for Four New Jersey Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury, be it resolved by the City of Woodbury, Gloucester County, New Jersey, that:

The City of Woodbury adopts the Mitigation Plan for Four New Jersey Counties and the City of Woodbury Appendix including authorizing the formation and duties of the City of Woodbury Hazard Mitigation Working Group ("Working Group") as follows:

- 1. The Working Group shall be convened by the City of Woodbury Emergency Management Coordinator and will include representatives of the following departments, agencies, and organizations and other interested parties determined by the Emergency Management Coordinator:
 - a. Police Department
 - b. Fire Department
 - c. Public Works Department
 - d. City Administration
- 2. The Working Group shall convene to conduct plan implementation and maintenance activities as identified in the City of Woodbury Appendix including monitoring, evaluation, and updating the City of Woodbury Appendix and providing annual reports to the City of Woodbury and the Gloucester Office of Emergency Management.
