

**RESOLUTION #16-51**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY (P-6785-16)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodbury wishes to apply for funding of approximately \$58,524.59, with a match of \$138,552.41, for an approximate project total cost of \$197,077.00, for a project under the State of New Jersey Safe and Secure Communities Program 2016 (Grant #P-6785-16); and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council has reviewed the accompanying application and has approved said request; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the City of Woodbury for the purpose described in the application;


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that:

- 1) As a matter of public policy the City of Woodbury wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety.
- 2) The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of the applicant.
- 3) The Division of Criminal Justice shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the applications for said funds.
- 4) The Division of Criminal Justice shall initiate allocations to each applicant as authorized.
