

RESOLUTION #17-08

**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE SOUTH JERSEY TIMES
AND THE COURIER POST AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPERS FOR
NOTICES OF PUBLIC MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate the official newspaper in which public notices, advertisements and requests for bids shall appear; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231, P.L. 1975 (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.), requires that certain notices of meetings be submitted to two (2) newspapers, one of which shall be the official newspaper; and


WHEREAS, these newspapers are designated by this body as the newspapers which have the greatest likelihood of informing the public within the jurisdictional boundaries of the body of such meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, as follows:


1. That the South Jersey Times, 161 Bridgeton Pike, Bldg. E, Mullica Hill, New Jersey 08062, be designated as the official publication for the City of Woodbury and the Courier Post, P.O. Box 5300, Cherry Hill, New Jersey 08034, is hereby designated the secondary newspaper, and they are designated to receive all notices of meetings as required under the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.

2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
