

**RESOLUTION # 17-111**

**RESOLUTION TO APPOINT TAX AND UTILITY COLLECTOR  
FOR THE CITY OF WOODBURY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodbury is in need of a licensed tax collector due to the impending retirement on July 31, 2017 of Lorraine Reeves who currently serves as the City of Woodbury's tenured Tax Collector; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodbury has advertised for a New Jersey Licensed Tax Collector and has received several applications; and

**WHEREAS**, the personnel committee has reviewed the resumes submitted and conducted interviews, and recommends to the governing body that Theresa Mulvenna be appointed as the new City of Woodbury New Jersey Licensed Tax Collector; and

**WHEREAS**, Theresa Mulvenna is a duly licensed Tax Collector pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:9-145.7*; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:9-142*, the initial appointment of a municipal tax collector is for a term of four (4) years from the first day of January next following her appointment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury that:


1. Theresa Mulvenna is hereby appointed as the City of Woodbury's licensed Tax Collector effective August 1, 2017, for a term expiring December 31, 2021 or until her successor is appointed and qualified, whichever occurs last at an annual salary of \$68,000.00; and

2. Theresa Mulvenna shall have an employment start date of July 24, 2017 to allow for a transition period with the current Tax/Utility Collector.
