

RESOLUTION #17-92

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN ASPHALT HOT BOX THROUGH NATIONAL JOINT POWER ALLIANCE (NJPA) COOPERATIVE PURCHASING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is in need of an Asphalt Hot Box for the purpose of repairs to City roadways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-116, the City of Woodbury is a member of the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Cooperative Purchasing System; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2, as amended by P.L. 2011, c.139, authorizes the City to purchase goods or to contract for services through the use of a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing system that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding process by another contracting unit within the State of New Jersey, or within any other state, when available; and

WHEREAS, the nationally-recognized National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA") cooperative purchasing system, located in Minnesota, offers voluntary participation in its cooperative purchasing system for the purchase of goods and services from NJPA vendors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury wishes to purchase the following items through the NJPA vendor, Falcon Asphalt Repair Equipment, LLC, Midland, MI:

Falcon 4 Ton RME Asphalt Hot Patch Equipment

WHEREAS, purchases through NJPA comply with the Local Public Contract Law Requirements; and

WHEREAS, the CFO has certified the availability of funds for such purchases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, that the Mayor and/or Acting Administrator are hereby authorized to execute such documents as necessary to effectuate the purchase of the above-referenced Asphalt Hot Box through NJPA for a total purchase price not-to-exceed \$34,407.00.
