

ORDINANCE #2212-14

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY AMENDING
CHAPTER 190-31 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY
PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF HUNTER STREET**


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury have determined that in order to promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Woodbury and promote the safe flow of traffic that it is desirable to prohibit parking on the North Side of Hunter Street from the corner intersecting Broad Street extending 235 feet to the entrance of the parking garage.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that Chapter 190-31, Schedule I, No Parking of the Code of the City of Woodbury is hereby amended to add No Parking on the North Side of Hunter Street from the corner intersecting Broad Street extending 235 feet to the entrance of the parking garage.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on August 12, 2014. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on August 26, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
