

**ORDINANCE NO. 2275-17**

**ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY  
AMENDING CHAPTER 139. PEACE AND GOOD ORDER OF  
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY**

**WHEREAS**, the following amendments to Chapter 139 have been recommended to the Mayor and Council; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury as follows:

Chapter 139. Peace and Good Order of the Code of the City of Woodbury, §139-8, §139-9, §139-17 and §139-18 shall be **AMENDED** and henceforth read as follows and all other Sections remain in full force and effect:

**§139-8. Lewd or indecent behavior, literature or representations.**

No person shall appear in any street or public place in the City in a state of nudity or make any indecent exposure of his or her person or be guilty of any lewd or indecent act or behavior.

**§139-9. Disorderly conduct in libraries.**

No person shall disturb or interrupt the quiet and order of any public library or reading room within the City, nor shall any person conduct himself or herself in a noisy or disorderly manner in any such public library or reading room so as to disturb those who resort thereto for the purposes of reading or study nor enter nor remain in the library without a shirt or other covering over their upper bodies or without shoes.

**§139-17. Spitting in public.**


No person shall expectorate upon the sidewalks or in a vehicle for hire or any common carrier or in any public or quasi-public building within the City.

**§ 139-18. Sunday activities. DELETED in its entirety.**


**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

**THE FOREGOING** was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on November 28, 2017. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on December 12, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
