**RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY, IN
THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY
TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE FAIR FUNDING ACTION COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the School Funding Reform Act (SFRA) the City of Woodbury School District is an underfunded school district; and

WHEREAS, attention must be called to the Commissioner of Education, legislators, and the Governor of the State of New Jersey, demanding that our public schools are finding equitably; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Funding Action Committee is recognized as a statewide fair school funding activist organization with the ability to coordinate and connect other underfunded school districts statewide;

WHEREAS, the Fair Funding Action Committee's objective is to achieve full and equitable school funding for all of New Jersey Public Schools through the allocation of state school aid in accordance to SRFA, without applying adjustment aid ("Hold Harmless Aid") or enrollment growth caps in time for Boards of Education to strike their next school budgets;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Woodbury will become a member of the Fair Funding Action Committee.
