

ORDINANCE # 2283-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #2263-17 TO FIX AND ESTABLISH SALARIES AND RATE OF COMPENSATION ON THE VARIOUS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, AND TO PROVIDE THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The payment of all salaries and compensation required to be made under the provisions of this ordinance shall be on an annual, bi-weekly, quarterly or hourly pays-per-year basis commencing with the first pay period of January 2018, or as otherwise noted below.

SECTION 2. The salary of the following officers and employees classifications shall be:

SECTION 2A. ANNUAL SALARY (Paid in 26 Bi-Weekly Pays in 2018)

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as required by law. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of the ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and City Council, of the City of Woodbury, on April 24, 2018 and finally passed at a regular meeting held on May 8, 2018.
