

ORDINANCE NO. 2285-18

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY AMENDING
CHAPTER 190 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY**

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Police Department have recommended that Section 190-7, Article II: Parking and Section 190-32, Article XII: Schedules of the Code of the City of Woodbury be amended to prohibit parking on both sides of High Street only on the first Wednesday of each month between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. for the month's of April through December to allow for street sweeping; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council have determined that the recommended amendments will promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Woodbury.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that Chapter 190-7B. Parking Prohibited Certain Hours, is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

B. Any vehicle parked between the hours specified in Chapter 190-32, Article XII, Schedule II, of any day except Sundays, and public holidays upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in said Schedule II attached to and made a part of this Chapter shall be subject to being towed at the direction of the Woodbury City Police Department at owner's expense.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that Chapter 190-32, Article XII, Schedule II: No Parking Certain Hours of the Code of the City of Woodbury regarding parking on High Street is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location
High Street	Both	6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. First Wednesday of Each Month, April through December	From Broad Street to Glover Street


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other provisions of said Ordinance not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect and any ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of any inconsistency.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any portion of the within Ordinance is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, same shall not affect the remaining portions of the within Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on May 22, 2018. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on June 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.




