WHEREAS; the Director of the Division of Local Government Services has promulgated rules and regulations for pilot programs, and


WHEREAS; the rules and regulations authorize a municipality to conduct an electronic tax sale, and

WHEREAS; an electronic tax sale is innovative and provides a greater pool of potential lien buyers, thus creating the environment for a more complete tax sale process, and


WHEREAS; THE City of Woodbury wishes to conduct an electronic tax sale.
