ORDINANCE NO. 2323-20

REFUNDING BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF THE CITY'S OUTSTANDING CALLABLE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 2009, DATED NOVEMBER 18, 2009; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$3,750,000 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY, TO FINANCE THE COSTS THEREOF; MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS AND COVENANTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE FOREGOING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council ("Council") of the City of Woodbury, County of Gloucester, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of 1960 of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

Section 1. The City of Woodbury, County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("City"), is hereby authorized to refund up to all of its outstanding callable General Obligation Bonds, Series 2009, dated November 18, 2009, in the aggregate principal amount of \$3,550,000 and maturing as follows (collectively, the "Callable Bonds"):

The exact principal amount of Callable Bonds to be refunded (which may be less than all of the Callable Bonds) shall be determined pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Council by not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof.

Section 2. To effectuate the refunding of up to all of the Callable Bonds, negotiable general obligation refunding bonds of the City are hereby authorized to be issued in one or more series in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$3,750,000 ("Refunding Bonds"), pursuant to the Local Bond Law. The exact principal amount of Refunding Bonds to be issued and terms thereof shall be determined pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Council by not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof.

Section 3. An aggregate amount not exceeding \$150,000 for the items of expense listed in and permitted by Section 51.b. of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-51.b., has been included in the aggregate principal amount of the Refunding Bonds authorized herein.

Section 4. The purpose of the Refunding Bonds is to effect an interest cost savings for the City.

Section 5. Each Refunding Bond authorized herein shall be designated, substantially, "City of Woodbury, County of Gloucester, New Jersey, General Obligation Refunding Bond, Series 202_" and shall be in the form prescribed and permitted by the Local Bond Law, as Bond Counsel may advise, and as the City shall approve.

Section 6. The Refunding Bonds may be sold at public or private sale pursuant to a resolution of the Council adopted by not less than two-thirds of the full members thereof.

Section 7. The supplemental debt statement provided for in Section 10 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-10, was duly filed in the office of the City Clerk prior to the passage of this refunding bond ordinance on first reading and a complete executed duplicate original thereof has been filed in the Office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey.

Section 8. A certified copy of this refunding bond ordinance as adopted on first reading has been filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey prior to final adoption, together with a complete statement in the form prescribed by the Director and signed by the Chief Financial Officer of the City as to the outstanding indebtedness to be refunded by the issuance of the Refunding Bonds.

Section 9. This refunding bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

ORDINANCE 2324-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY ESTABLISHING A JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD; REPEALING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 12, COURT, OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY; AND APPROVING A JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE OPERATION OF THE JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF DEPTFORD

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A., 2B-12-1(b) authorizes the formation of Joint Municipal Court provided that an Agreement is entered into by the City of Woodbury and the Township of Deptford provided that the Agreement is filed with the State of New Jersey Administrative Director of the Courts and the Assignment Judge of the Superior Court of New Jersey, Gloucester County; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodbury has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to establish a Joint Municipal Court with the Township of Deptford; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury further desires to enter into an Agreement to form a Joint Municipal Court with the Township of Deptford and participate in the Joint Municipal Court with this municipality; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Joint Municipal Court participants (hereinafter referred to as “Participating Municipalities”) wish and desire to establish a Joint Municipal Court upon the terms and conditions established by the Joint Municipal Court Agreement approved by this Ordinance and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodbury deems it in the best interest of the City to accordingly abolish the East Greenwich Joint Municipal Court and establish a Joint Municipal Court for the Participating Municipalities named herein, to be known as the “Deptford Joint Municipal Court.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey that, as follows:

Section 1.

The East Greenwich Joint Municipal Court is hereby abolished as of January 1, 2020 at 12:00 a.m. and Chapter 12 of the City Code is hereby repealed, in its entirety, and amended to read as follows:

§ 1. Abolishment.

The East Greenwich Joint Municipal Court shall be abolished as of January 1, 2020 at 12:00 a.m., and after due notice is given as set forth in § 12-2. All summonses and other appropriate matters issuing or arising from the City of Woodbury and the Township of Deptford shall be processed in the Deptford Joint Municipal Court on and after April 22, 2020, including those matters arising prior to April 22, 2020, which remain pending.

§ 2. Notice of Abolishment.

Notice of repeal and abolishment of the East Greenwich Joint Municipal Court and the Municipal Court of the Township of Deptford, and the establishment of the Deptford Joint Municipal Court, shall be provided, in writing, to the Administrative Offices of the Courts and the Assignment Judge of Vicinage 15, and posted in the municipal buildings of the participating municipalities in a location where public notices are normally posted.

§ 3. Agreement.

The responsibility for the operation of the Deptford Joint Municipal Court shall be set forth in a Shared Services Agreement, the "Agreement for the Operation of a Joint Municipal Court" approved by resolutions of the City of Woodbury and the Township of Deptford.

§ 4. Establishment.

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1 et seq., the Deptford Joint Municipal Court is hereby established.

§ 5. Seal.

The Deptford Joint Municipal Court shall have an official seal which shall bear the impression of the name of the Court.

§ 6. Jurisdiction.

The territorial jurisdiction of the Deptford Joint Municipal Court shall be coextensive with the territory of the City of Woodbury and the Township of Deptford, Gloucester County, New Jersey.

§ 7. Location.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish a single Joint Municipal Court to be located at the County Justice Complex, 70 Hunter Street, Woodbury, New Jersey J 08096.

§ 8. Municipal Judge, appointment and jurisdiction.

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 2B:12-4, as amended, the Judge of the Deptford Joint Municipal Court shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate and shall have the qualifications required by law and shall serve for a term of three years from the date of his/her appointment and until his/her successor has been appointed and has qualified. The compensation of the judge shall be an annual salary as is

now or hereinafter may be provided by ordinance and in accordance with the terms of the agreement for the operation of a Joint Municipal Court between the City of Woodbury and the Township of Deptford.

§ 9. Joint Municipal Court Administrator.

There shall be a Joint Municipal Court Administrator and Deputy Court Administrator who shall be appointed as provided by this article and in accordance with the terms of the agreement for the operation of a Joint Municipal Court between the City of Woodbury and Township of Deptford.

§ 10. Support staff.

The Deptford Joint Municipal Court support staff shall be appointed in accordance with the terms of the agreement for the operation of a Joint Municipal Court between the City of Woodbury and Township of Deptford.

§ 11. Joint Municipal Court Prosecutor.

The Joint Municipal Court Prosecutor shall be appointed in accordance with the terms of the agreement for the operation of a Joint Municipal Court between the City of Woodbury and Township of Deptford. The Joint Municipal Court Prosecutor shall have the jurisdiction, powers and duties prescribed by N.J.S.A. 2B:25-1 et seq.

§ 12. Joint Municipal Court Public Defender.

A. Appointment. The Joint Municipal Court Public Defender shall be appointed in accordance with the terms of the agreement for the operation of a Joint Municipal Court between the City of Woodbury and Township of Deptford. The Joint Municipal Court Public Defender shall have the jurisdiction, powers and duties prescribed by N.J.S.A. 2B:24.1 et seq.

B. Representation. Any person applying to the Deptford Joint Municipal Court for representation by a municipal public defender shall, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2B:24-17, pay an application fee, but only in an amount determined by the Joint Municipal Court Judge, necessary to pay the costs of municipal public defender services. The Joint Municipal Court Judge may waive said application fee in whole or in part if the court determines, in its discretion, that the application fee represents an unreasonable burden on the person seeking representation. Said determination shall be made in accordance with the applicable provisions under law.

C. Alternate method of collection. If the payment of the fee is deferred by the Joint Municipal Court Judge or the fee is otherwise unpaid, then the participating municipalities may endeavor to collect the fee in the manner provided in N.J.S.A.

40:6A-1 and N.J.S.A. 2A:158A-19. Collection of such fees by a third party shall be authorized by both Woodbury and East Greenwich.

Section 2. Approval of Shared Services Agreement

The City Council of the City of Woodbury hereby approves of the terms and conditions of the Shared Services Agreement between the Participating Municipalities to establish the “Deptford Joint Municipal Court”, such Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The Council President and the Clerk of the City of Woodbury are hereby expressly authorized to execute and deliver the aforesaid Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3. Repealer.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. Severability.

If any provisions of this Ordinance or the application of this Ordinance to any person, entity or circumstance is held invalid by any Court of jurisdiction, the remainder of such provisions of this Ordinance not so deemed invalid shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be effective upon the last to occur of the following:

- A. Its adoption and publication in accordance with law; and
- B. Approval of the Joint Municipal Court by the Administrative Office of the Courts and the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court Vicinage 15; and
- C. An ordinance duly authorized and passed by the governing bodies of the Township of Deptford authorizing the establishment of the Joint Municipal Court; and
- D. Approved by resolution by City of Woodbury and Township of Deptford of an agreement for the operation of a Joint Municipal Court.

CHAPTER 141. PEDDLING AND SOLICITING, SECTION 141-22. CHARITABLE OR
CIVIC NONPROFIT FESTIVALS, OF THE CODEBOOK OF THE CITY OF
WOODBURY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Woodbury, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 141, Peddling and Soliciting, Section 22, Charitable or civil nonprofit festivals, Part D(5) of the Code of the City of Woodbury is hereby amended to read:

a. The City of Woodbury sets forth the following special event merchandise fee. The goal of this new fee schedule is to encourage participation in special events sponsored by charitable organizations.

Number of Vendors Participating in the Special Event*	Fee
0 to 5 vendors	\$100
6 to 10 vendors	\$200
11 to 15 vendors	\$300
16 to 20 vendors	\$400
20+ vendors	\$500

*If the vendor is a business or another nonprofit entity located in the City of Woodbury, then said vendor is not included in the count.

b. The City Council of the City of Woodbury reserves the right to waive special event merchandise fees at its discretion.

Section 2. Repealer: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3. Severability: Each section of this Ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective, shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other sections or parts hereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law

MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR THE FOURTH OF JULY PUBLIC
FIREWORKS DISPLAY**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury will again sponsor this year's public display of fireworks to be held at the Woodbury High School and the Frances Avenue Complex on the evening of Sunday, July 5, 2020, with the rain date to be Sunday, July 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is desirous of continuing the tradition of a Fourth of July public fireworks display by sponsoring said event; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury wishes to engage **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks** for the July 5, 2020 fireworks display in the amount of **\$11,000**; and

WHEREAS, such display will be supervised by competent and experienced persons in compliance with N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, and will not be a detriment to the community, but to the contrary will offer substitute for the heretofore indiscriminate and unlawful use of fireworks on the part of the individuals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, as follows:

1. Pursuant to the authority granted under N.J.S.A. 21:3-1, N.J.S.A. 21:3-3 and N.J.S.A. 21:3-4 of the State of New Jersey, the City Clerk and/or Administrator of the City of Woodbury be and hereby authorized to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient license of permit to the City of Woodbury, authorizing the public display of fireworks at the Woodbury High School property and/or Frances Avenue Complex during the evening of Sunday, July 5, 2020 at approximately 9:00 p.m., eastern daylight time, under the supervision of **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks, PO Box 149, New Castle PA 16103**, a fully qualified pyrotechnical firm, the company named in the application heretofore submitted to the Fire Marshal. Said fireworks are to be delivered on Sunday, July 5, 2020 and will remain on the truck at the Woodbury High School and/or Frances Avenue Complex until set up. Said license shall be without force and effect until such time as the fireworks display company, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks**, shall file with the Fire Marshal insurance coverage naming the City of Woodbury, the Township of West Deptford, and the Woodbury School District as additional insureds, including a statutory bond, which are satisfactory to the Solicitor, which would indemnify any person who may receive or sustain injury to his or her person or property by reason of any discharge of the fireworks in question and a Hold Harmless Agreement to the benefit of the City of Woodbury, in a form satisfactory to the Solicitor. All operations incidental to such display shall be subject to the approval of the Chief of Police and Fire Department of the City of Woodbury as required by law; and

2. If the rain date that is established is beyond the ninety-six (96) hour limit, the fireworks will be removed from the storage area in the City and returned to the site twenty-four (24) hours prior to a new date of fireworks display. The storage area will be the middle of the Frances Avenue Fields; and

3. The Mayor, Jessica Floyd, is hereby authorized to execute a contract for the fireworks display between the City of Woodbury and the fireworks provider, **Pyrotecnico, Vitale Family Fireworks**.

4. Any city of Woodbury permit fees are hereby waived.
