

RESOLUTION NO. 20-87

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE 2020 LOCAL AID INFRASTRUCTURE FUND PROJECT HEREINAFTER KNOWN AS SOUTH COLUMBIA STREET RESURFACING

WHEREAS, The City of Woodbury is in need of resurfacing the roadway, including milling and overlay, removal of curb barriers at intersections, installation of bicycle-safe inlet grates, and replacing damaged or missing concrete curbing along South Columbia Street from Logan Street to Delaware Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has estimated the construction cost of the necessary improvements at approximately \$266,200 plus \$64,250 for construction management & inspection services, plus \$2,000 for materials testing for a total amount of \$332,450; and

WHEREAS, The City of Woodbury desires to prepare plans and specifications and to issue bid documents for construction in 2020, as funds become available.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Council of the City of Woodbury understands that the South Columbia Street Resurfacing Project will be constructed in 2020, and the City of Woodbury formally approves the grant application for the above-stated project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Administrator, Treasurer, City Clerk, and City Engineer are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as Application No. LAIF-2020-South Columbia Street-00020 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Woodbury; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Administrator, Treasurer, and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Woodbury and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.







RECOMMENDATION

PREVIOUS ACTION

BACKGROUND

Grant application is for discretionary aid from NJDOT-Local Aid for infrastructure improvement projects.

This grant is for the repaving of over 2,500 feet of South Columbia Street from Logan Street to Delaware Street, including extended portions of the intersections to repave beyond the crosswalk areas at Prince, Queen, King and High streets.

Excluding the intersections at Myrtle Avenue and West Centre Street that were repaved last year.

Const. mgmnt., inspection, testing = \$39,750
Total Construction Cost estimate = \$305,950
Eligible Design Engineering = \$26,500
Total Project Cost estimate = \$332,450
