

The Woodbury Public Library is closed until further notice as per NJ Executive Order No. 104 (2020) ordering the closure of all libraries to the public.

Dear Neighbors,

We thank you all for your patience during this unprecedented time. We recognize the important role the Woodbury Public Library plays as your community space, your information resource center, and of course, your favorite place to get new books. We greatly miss serving Woodbury, and we eagerly await State clearance to serve our community face-to-face again.

As of May 30, NJ Libraries continue to operate under Executive Order 107 and are therefore closed to the public. We are regularly monitoring updates in anticipation of Stage 2 of *The Road Back* initiative, in which the reopening of Libraries has been identified. Behind the scenes, we are busy planning for curbside pickup service once state restrictions have been lifted.

In the meantime, we continue to add new resources and content to our Facebook page and website and encourage you to enjoy the free eBooks, audiobooks, streaming music and video offered through our Hoopla Digital and Libby apps.
