

ORDINANCE #1991-05

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 162 OF THE WOODBURY
MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED: SOLID WASTE

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury that Chapter 162 of the Code of the City of Woodbury is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I. PURPOSE. The Mayor and City Council have been advised by the City Engineer that as a result of certain state mandated regulations concerning stormwater control and management that there is a need to amend Chapter 162 of the Code of the City of Woodbury in order to comply with said regulations.

SECTION II. AMENDMENT. The following amendments shall be made to Chapter 162, entitled "Solid Waste":


§162-13 Placement of receptacles for collection.


All receptacles required herein shall be supplied by the occupant and/or owner of the premises and placed prior to collection between the curb and sidewalk where they shall be readily accessible to the collector. The owner and/or occupant shall keep all receptacles clean and in condition for safe holding. The following regulations shall apply to the placement and removal of receptacles.


- A. No receptacle or other items to be deposited may be placed in front of the premises to be picked up prior to 5:00 p.m. of the day immediately preceding the day of collection.
- B. Upon collection, all receptacles or containers shall be removed no later than 7:00 p.m. of the scheduled day of collection.
- C. All receptacles, when not placed for curbside collection, shall be located to the rear of the property and shall not be subject to public view from the front of the property.
- D. The owner or occupant of any property, or any employee or contractor of such owner or occupant engaged to provide lawn care or landscaping services, shall not sweep, rake, blow or otherwise place yard waste, unless the yard waste is containerized, in the street. If yard waste that is not containerized is placed in the street, the party responsible for placement of yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street and said party shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance.
- E. Sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street is only allowed during the seven (7) days prior to a scheduled and announced collection, and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street at

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at its special budget meeting held on March 22, 2005. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on April 25, 2005 at 7:30 P.M. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's office to the members of the general public who may request same.
