**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY IN
SUPPORT OF THE CAMDEN-GLASSBORO LINE (GCL)**

WHEREAS, the Glassboro-Camden Line (GCL) is a proposed passenger rail line that would span from Camden to Glassboro with stops throughout the Southern New Jersey area; and

WHEREAS, there are two (2) proposed rail stops to be located in the City of Woodbury; and

WHEREAS, the GCL project is currently in the preliminary engineering phase; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the engineering phase, the GCL timeline is for construction to be completed and the line ready for operation some time toward the end of 2027-2028; and

WHEREAS, the GCL project will provide an opportunity for people to connect throughout the Philadelphia Metropolitan area as well as throughout the corridor along the Camden-Glassboro line; and

WHEREAS, based upon the two (2) proposed rail stops in the City of Woodbury along the GCL line, these rail stops will provide ample opportunities for use by its residents and employees working in the City and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the GCL will have a major impact on the proposed redevelopment projects and existing redevelopment areas adjacent to the GCL line within the City; and

WHEREAS, the GCL is anticipated to have a major impact on the former Inspira Hospital proposed development project by providing improved passenger rail access to the City including the potential for the development of a Transit Village Hub within the immediate area; and

WHEREAS, the GCL would extend job opportunities to businesses located within Woodbury and within the surrounding communities and extend job opportunities by providing available access to the City; and

WHEREAS, the GCL would offer an alternative automobile dependency by restoring past passenger rail service to the City and to the surrounding communities who now have limited public transit options and the GCL would create affordable transit options and reduce the level of congestion on increasingly overburdened roadways such as Evergreen Avenue, Cooper Street and Broad Street; and

WHEREAS, the GCL will help reduce the City's carbon footprint, increase property value for homeowners and increase economic opportunity for businesses and provide a convenient means of transportation for residents, employees and visitors who want easy access to the City including the proposed new state of the art Inspira Hospital Emergency Room facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Woodbury, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the City Council does hereby acknowledge its continued commitment to and their continued support of the completion of the Camden-Glassboro Line, which upon completion, will be an invaluable future asset for the overall planning, development and redevelopment of not only the City of Woodbury but all of the communities along and surrounding the GCL rail line.
2. That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Gloucester County Board of Commissioners, and all members of the adjoining New Jersey Legislative Districts to the GCL and to the Governor's Office.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY
ESTABLISHING A WOODBURY CANNABIS LICENSE APPLICATION EVALUATION
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury adopted Ordinance 2354-22 Establishing a New Chapter for the Licensing, Registration, and Regulation of Cannabis Establishments on February 23, 2022 in order to set forth criteria to evaluate applications for Woodbury Cannabis Licenses; and

WHEREAS, to assist in the evaluation of Woodbury Cannabis License Applications, the City has a need to appoint a Cannabis License Application Evaluation Committee; and

WHEREAS, it shall be the responsibility of this Committee to evaluate complete Cannabis License Applications using the criteria set forth in Ordinance 2354-22.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Woodbury that the Cannabis License Application Evaluation Committee be and is hereby created and that its members shall include the City of Woodbury Administrator, the City of Woodbury Zoning Officer, and the City of Woodbury Chief of Police or his designee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cannabis License Application Evaluation Committee shall henceforth review all complete Woodbury Cannabis License Applications under the criteria set forth in Ordinance 2354-22 and make recommendations to Council regarding the acceptance or rejection of such applications based on those criteria.
