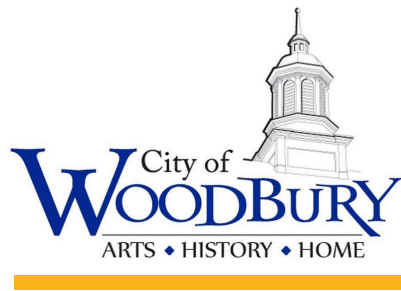


## Expanding Recreation Space Phase III

- Build a pedestrian path network approximately 2 miles in length. The path is to be built alongside a series of lakes between South Evergreen Avenue (County Route [CR] 553) to the south and North Broad Street (Route 45) to the north. The proposed pedestrian path will measure approximately 8 feet wide and consist of a porous asphalt material.
- It will feature several scenic overlooks, footbridges and boardwalks, benches, and other amenities, and will require the construction of bulkheads in various locations. Street crossings along the proposed path network will be improved through the installation of ADA-compliant curb ramps and painted crosswalks at existing intersections and mid-block crossings.
- The proposed new path will connect to the recently completed Green Acres-funded path along the west and north banks of the Stewart Lake portion of Woodbury Creek.







## Project Funding

## How is the Project Funded?

- In May of 2023, the City of Woodbury was awarded \$1,500,000 dollars in Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program funding to expand the pathway system along our water ways.
- The grant awarded is being administered via the NJ Department of Transportation and they have been the primary project manager to ensure this project stays on track.



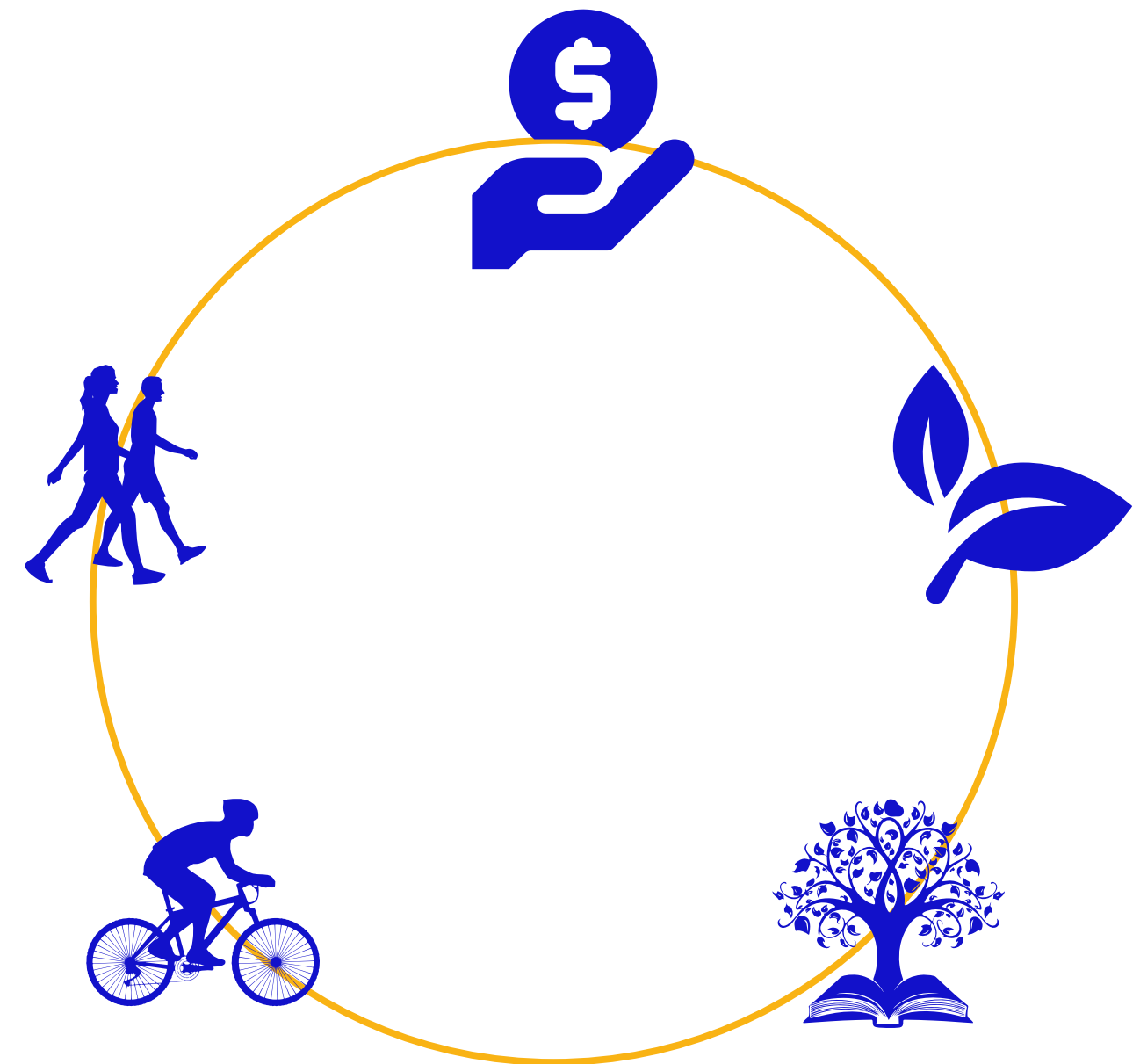

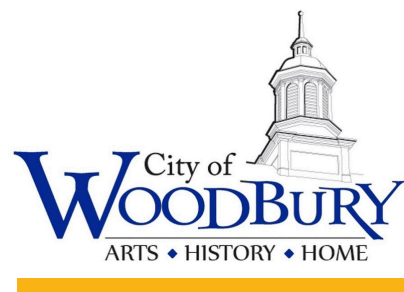


## Benefits Of The Path Expansion

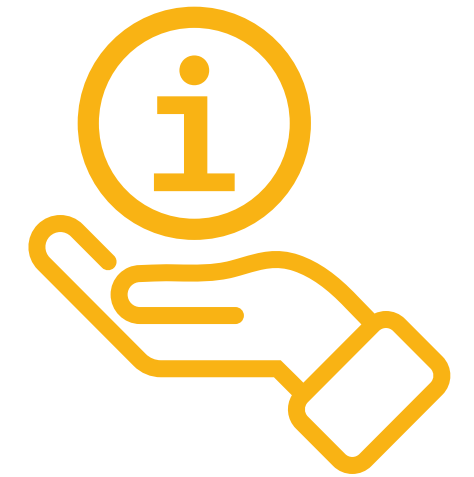
- \$0.00 to the taxpayer.
