REMINDERS

- You must apply for a Mail-In Ballot for each election, unless you designate otherwise under Section 1 on the Application for Vote by Mail Ballot.
- If returning your Mail-In Ballot in person, it must be received by the County Board of Elections by 8 pm on Election Day. You CAN NOT return your Mail-In Ballot to a polling location.
- If returning your Mail-In Ballot by mail, it must be postmarked no later than Election Day and received by the County Board of Elections no later than 6 days (November 10th) after the time for the closing of the polls of the election.
- You can check on the status of your Mail-in Ballot using the Track My Ballot Portal online or you can contact the County Clerk's office at 856-384-3234.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING

Saturday, October 25th - Sunday, November 2nd
Hours - 10 am-8 pm (Monday-Saturday),
10 am-6 pm (Sunday).

Gloucester County voters may go to any of the 5 designated early voter centers. The 2 closest are:

- Riverwinds Community Center - 1000 Riverwinds Dr, Thorofare, NJ, 08086
- RCSJ Business and Corporate Center - 1400 Tanyard Rd, Sewell, NJ, 08080

VOTE BY MAIL

Registered voters have until October 28th (7 days prior to the election) to request a Mail-In Ballot.

If returning your Mail-In Ballot in person, it must be received by the County Board of Elections by 8 pm on Election Day. You CAN NOT return your Mail-In Ballot to a polling location.

If returning your Mail-In Ballot by mail, it must be postmarked no later than Election Day and received by the County Board of Elections no later than 6 days (November 10th) after the time for the closing of the polls of the election.
